



GUIDE FOR HIGH SCHOOL TEAM MEMBERS

Mentoring a High School Team in a Canstruction Houston Competition

- Paying for High School's registration fee.
- Meet with school prior to end of year to ensure that a design can be made by September 1
- Design structure or work quickly with high school team so that can information can be provided to info@canstruction-houston.com by September 4 at 11:59 pm
- Select cans to be used or work quickly with high school team so that can information can be submitted to info@canstruction-houston.com
- Ensure team has flooring protection for structure.
- Provide team shirts
- Help high school team with any supply purchases needed – tape, etc.
- Provide architectural, stacking skills, reviewing rules with students, provide guidance about structural integrity.
- Ensure high school teams submit all the required paperwork to Canstruction Houston. PDF to info@canstruction-houston.com
- Provide guidance on how to use their can supply wisely, since high school teams will be provided a set amount of cans from our sponsor.
- This year we will be awarding cans from HEB to each high school team.
- During build day, ensure they focus on safety so none of them get hurt (i.e. falling off a ladder-someone holds the ladder, no throwing of cans, no running, etc.)
- Ensures team sends thank you notes after the event to HEB for can donations for sponsoring them.
- Can pick up/delivery to site will be discussed in detail at Canstruction 101/site selection
- Mentors must attend CANSTRUCTION 101 and Site Selection.
- Many of our mentors meet with the high school team once or twice a month. Provide an e-mail contact for questions from teams.
- Mentors need to ensure the structure will be sound and will hold up during display week.
- Mentors need to plan on attending build day with their team to help with the structure.
- No outside food or drink will be permitted at George R. Brown.
